

### Exploring the Seasons for Growth

Seasons for Growth is a 4 week small group programme. It is designed to help participants to explore the nature of and impact of change, loss and grief on the lives of individuals. It aims to build resilience and bring hope and confidence to adults who have experienced significant change or loss. Grief may be due to any number of experiences; bereavement, relationship breakdown, change in health, loss of job, change in living situation or a natural disaster.

A four week workshop will be held on March 7, 14, 21, and 28th (Thursdays) from 9:30-12:30 at St Andrews Church Lounge.
